GALALA will be Broadcast starting spring 2015 on the channel Unis, and will provide a unique opportunity for talented youth to show their talent to a Canada-wide audience. All artistic art forms are welcomed – singing, music, dance, slam, comedy, public speaking, choir, martial arts, magic or circus acts, in a group or solo – we are looking for enthusiasm and passion!

The selection process will lead to the Grand Gala of GALALA in Hawkesbury in Ontario, where the 10 regional competition finalists will find themselves on the red carpet, and where the first recipient of the Grand Trophy GALALA will be awarded. An action-packed experience that can lead to further opportunities!

Each episode of GALALA will show incredible regions of our beautiful and vast country. The regional competitions will take place in 10 selected cities.
